Answer:

Your Privacy Officer should act as your first contact for any questions you might have. They have resources specific to your department. Also, did you know:

- ❖ Your Privacy Officer welcomes questions.
- ❖ Your Privacy Officer can help you understand privacy and security rules for any particular situation. For example, ask questions when you have a new assignment or begin using or collecting different kinds of personally identifiable information (PII).
