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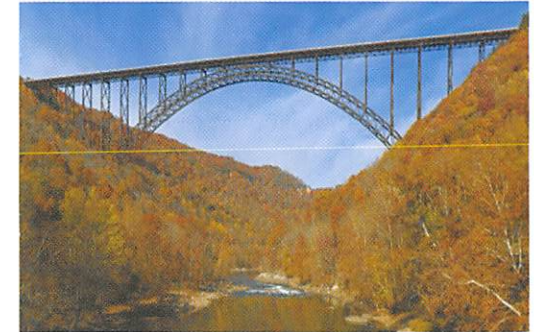

ADRN Overview

The West Virginia Aging and Disability Resource Network serves as a highly visible, trusted and valued organization where people of all incomes can turn to for information on the full range of long term support options through a person centered planning process. The ADRN will serve as a point of entry to access programs and benefits.

- Empower individuals and families to make more informed decisions
- Streamline access to a wide array of services offered through public and private resources

Who is Eligible for ADRN Services?

ADRN services are available statewide for anyone over 60 years of age, individuals with physical disabilities over 18 years of age, and those who act on behalf of said individuals.

What Services are Provided?

- Information & Referral
- Person Centered Counseling on available Long Term Services
- Screening and application assistance for programs such as SNAP, Medicaid, Medicare Savings Program, LIEAP, free cell phone, and Veteran's Benefits

What are Some Examples of Long-Term Services and Supports?

Some examples of LTSS are: personal care services, transportation, home delivered meals, adult day care, and respite services.

Is There a Fee for ADRN Services?

There is no charge for services provided by the ADRN.
