Here is a quiz to test your privacy knowledge!

1. Which of the following is **NOT** considered **sensitive PII (SPII)** and does not require greater protection?
 - a. Health information and medical records
 - b. Social security numbers
 - c. City and state of residence
 - d. Driver's license numbers

2. The Minimum Necessary and Limited Use Principle:
 - a. Demonstrates our commitment to collecting PII directly from the individual, where possible.
 - b. Departments shall limit the collection and disclosure of PII to their legal authority.
 - c. To compare our actual practices to the promises we made. This helps us ensure that we are actually doing what we tell people we do.
 - d. Implements the appropriate management, operational, physical and technical controls to preserve privacy, confidentiality, and accessibility of personally identifiable information.

3. What is the definition of confidentiality?
 - a. The ability to access information and services; the functionality and possible benefit, of some system or entity.
 - b. Maintaining systems and communications to acceptable operational status.
 - c. Conformity in fulfilling legal or official policy requirements.
 - d. The assurance that data will only be exposed to those with a lawful right and need to use.

1. **c.** City and state of residence are not considered SPPII, but may be considered PII when combined with other personal information.
2. **b.** Requires us to give people choice when we collect PII that isn't strictly necessary for the process at hand. (**Bonus question – do you know which policies include the other choices?**)
3. **d.** The assurance that data will only be exposed to those with a lawful right and need to use.
